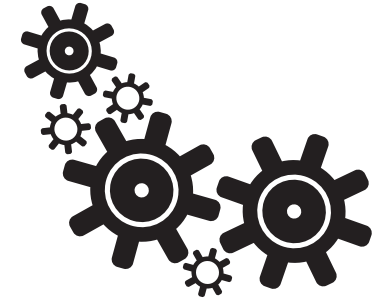

WEEK 1: Air, Air, Everywhere!
July 6 - 10
Learn that air is all around us and, even if we cannot see it, our bodies and the Earth need it. Learn how our lungs work, how air moves objects, and explore with rockets, kites, and more.

WEEK 2: Mixing and Exploring
July 13 - 17
We'll have fun measuring and mixing ingredients together to make new play substances. We'll also create melting snowmen, sidewalk chalk, & more.

WEEK 3: Sticky Squishy Sensory Creations
July 20 - 24
Explore the world through your senses! Young kids learn best when they can see it bubble, feel it squish, smell it fizz, or even taste it. Sensory science activities are perfect for preschoolers—it combines real science with hands-on activities.

WEEK 4: Geometry—Big and Small
July 27 - 31
By using pictures, blocks, and games, children will explore and analyze various 2D and 3D shapes and begin to recognize geometry all around us.

WEEK 5: Exploring Magnets
August 3 - 7
Children will quickly grasp the concept of magnetic poles and how magnets push and pull, while making Woolly Willy Faces, jumping magnets, and more.

WEEK 6: Coding Bootcamp
August 10 - 14
